That first quilt trail was hardly begun when a group of quilters from neighboring Brown County, Ohio, started their own project.

Each year more and more trails are created, and to date this simple idea has spread to 48 states and to Canada, and the trail continues to grow. Over 7,000 quilts are part of organized trails bringing together what has become the largest grassroots public arts movement in our history.

As is often the case, good ideas fall by the wayside but Donna Sue mentioned the project from time to time for several years.

Finally in 2001 she was encouraged by her friends to go ahead and paint that quilt square. Her work with the Ohio Arts Council and other community organizations inspired Donna Sue to alter her plan.

Rather than creating a personal tribute, she suggested that a "sampler" of twenty quilt squares could be created along a driving trail that

would invite visitors to travel through the countryside.

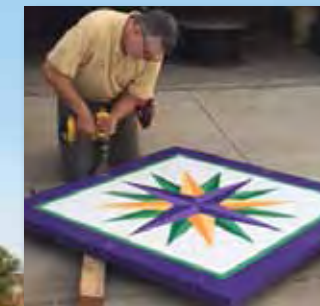
Ironically the first quilt square on the American Quilt Trail does not hang at the Groves farm, but at a greenhouse nearby- a location that allowed for a public celebration of the inauguration of the quilt trail. A Snail's Trail quilt square was later painted by an artist and mounted on the barn where Donna Sue and Maxine Groves reside.

The grand home that is today Quintealia's Tea Parlor was built in 1891 for the family of George Ford, son of Ohio Governor Seabury Ford (1849). George (whose portrait hangs above the fireplace in the parlor named after him) was the Village of Burton's first mayor. In addition to serving as a private home, over the years the mansion has been a restaurant, ice cream parlor, art co-op, and bridal studio.



Tearoom proprietresses Renee Petro and Annette Phillips are often asked "Where did the name Quintealia's come from?" The parlor's name was selected to honor Annette's grandmother, Quintilia, a woman of Italian descent who was nicknamed "Clara" by her employer when they found her given name difficult to pronounce. She went by Clara from then on. A variation in the spelling gave Annette and Renee an opportunity to play on the word "tea" while paying homage to a woman whose brave spirit epitomized their own leap of faith. A photograph of Quintilia graces the mantle in the front parlor, along with the tea set she gave Annette as a child.

Maple Sugaring... A Sweet Family Business

Several species of wood were used in the construction on the sugarhouse including Tulip Poplar, Red Oak, White Oak, Hickory, Hard Maple, Black Cherry, Sassafras, and Black Locust. The entire process of building the sugar house took over a year.

The current maple syrup operation processes sap from about 5000 taps and is expanding every year. As the use of new technology increases in the

maple syrup industry we try to maintain as much of the tradition associated with syrup making in Geauga County as possible. Our passion for making maple syrup and caring for our farm was instilled upon us by our parents Art and Donna Grossman, a family tradition that we are now passing on to the fourth generation of Grossman sugarmakers.

Our sugarhouse is located at 12147 Claridon-Troy Road and open to visitors **every weekend in March.**

their location in the frame After milling, the timbers were moved to Sweetgrass Joinery, where all of the wooden joinery was completed by Scott Carlson. After site preparation was completed the finished timbers were returned and the frame was erected during a traditional raising party, that included many friends and family members.

The frame was then covered with siding that was produced from the logs during the timber milling process.



The new sugarhouse was constructed in 2005. It is a traditional timber frame building using only wooden pegs to hold the frame work together. We harvested all of the trees necessary for its construction from the sugarbush. All of the trees were then milled on site to specific sizes depending on

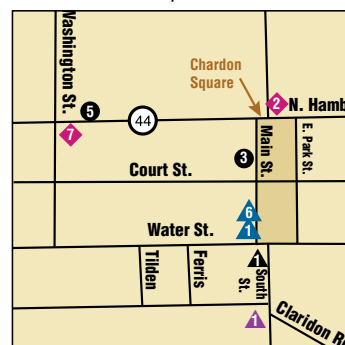

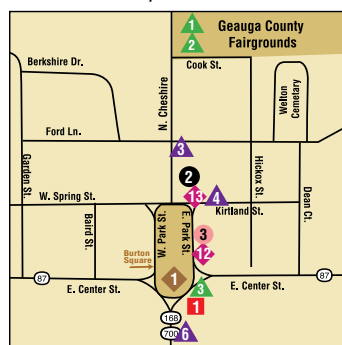

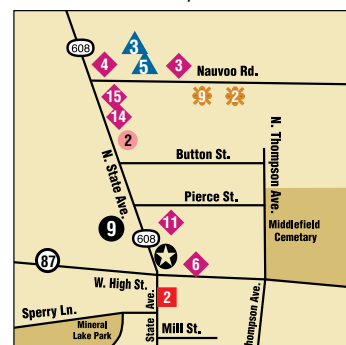
Chardon - Detail Map

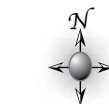

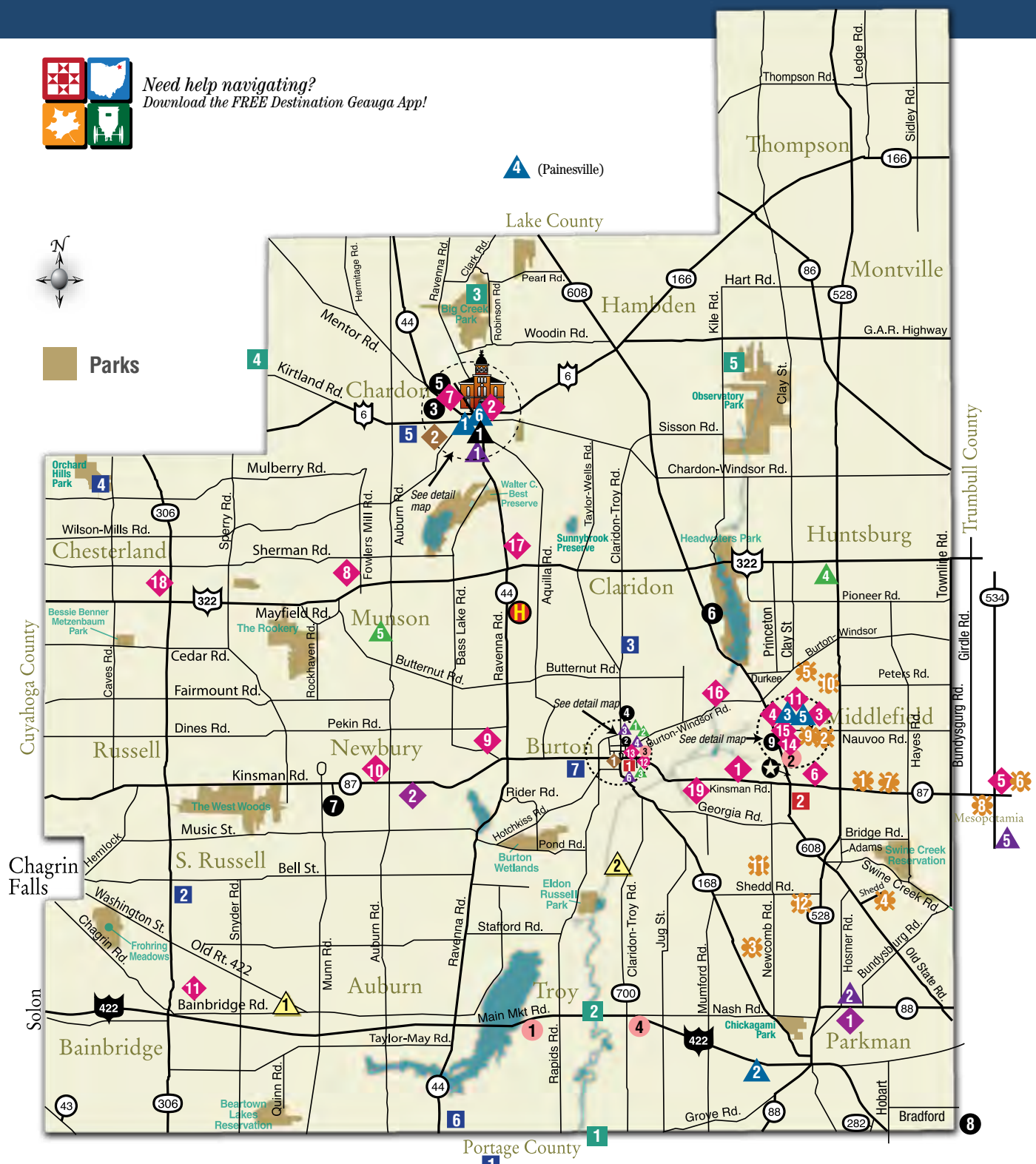

When I was a kid, my mother wouldn't let me go into antique stores with her for fear that I'd break something. On the rare occasions when I was allowed in, I was forbidden to touch anything. My sister on the other hand was the perfect angel and found her niche in antique stores at a young age.

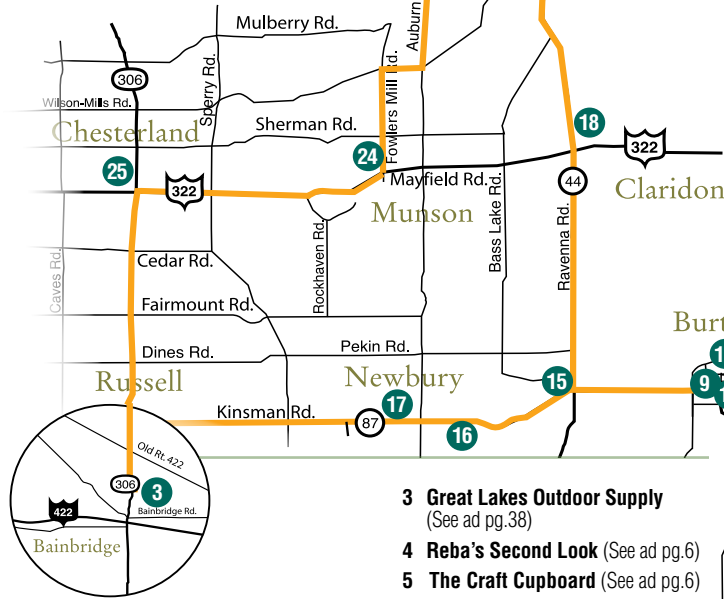

Get Fresh, Get Local, Get Flavor!

In the spring of 1997, the Sirna family purchased their property from a developer, at a higher price, in order to keep the property as it had been for the past century - Farmland. It was their first step in farmland preservation, and since then they have followed suit in being true stewards of their land and community



We bought a few Black Angus steer, some chickens, and planted the field with hay, pasture grass and of course a



The farm we purchased had not been worked in years and our family just wanted to enjoy it, and rural Geauga County, as we had recently moved from a developing city. With the help of the OSU Extension, attending classes and participating in the Master Garden program we started what was to be our 'hobby farm.'

garden. Our families had planted gardens, and Anne planted a garden at our previous home. Geauga County brought out the farmer in the gardener. We grew, expanded, invented and are still growing!

What an adventure! By the following year we were planting sweet corn, pumpkins, gourds and the garden had grown in size. To get rid of abundant crops from the garden, we put up a roadside stand and started selling our farm fresh produce. This was working out great and the hobby farm was starting to turn into a lot of work.

Since the original roadside stand, which was a tent, blew away several times, we built a farm market on the farm, which is open seasonally, 7 days a week. We continue to add products each year to meet our needs and better fill the demand in the community. Regardless of our size, we continue to emphasize education



and community by giving tours at the farm, and constantly bringing the farm to the table. Our farm market is exclusively local Ohio products, either from our farm or neighboring communities.

Since our expansion of Ohio products, and "local" making its path in the community – "Sirna's Farm" opened our own pizzeria which is truly farm to table, just two miles from the farm. Our farm is ever-changing and innovative, from grass fed beef, hydroponics, all natural produce using beneficial insects, to supporting other small businesses at the farm market... at the end of the day, we live by the mantra: *"Get Fresh. Get Local. Get Flavor."*

Ever wonder what you might find at the Market this week?

Here is a general "rule of thumb" sampling of fruit & vegetable harvest times in Geauga County. These are approximate since weather conditions vary.

Check with the individual markets for specific harvest dates.

Late May:
Asparagus, cabbage, radishes, rhubarb, spinach, and greens. A variety of plants, annuals, perennials, other vegetables and herbs.

Beginning in June:
Strawberries, raspberries, snap beans, beets, collards, green onions, endive, kale, lettuce, parsley, cilantro, scallions, zucchini & summer squash

July thru August:
Blueberries, blackberries, peaches, pole beans, cucumbers, carrots, eggplant, tomatoes, sweet corn, basil, dill, onions, sweet & hot peppers, leeks, okra, kohlrabi, potatoes, cantaloupe and melons

Late August thru October:
Apples & cider, grapes, watermelon, broccoli, cabbage, cauliflower, parsnips, turnips, pumpkins & other winter squash

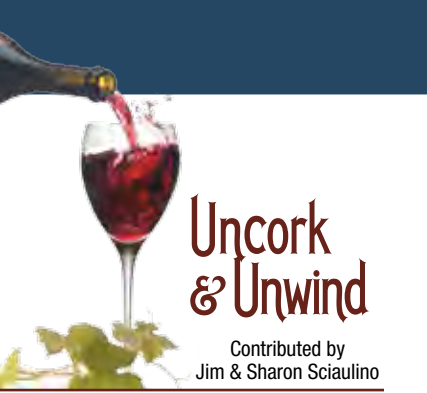

We want our guests to relax and forget about their stresses while enjoying fine wine. We also enjoy meeting new people and have come to make many new friends.



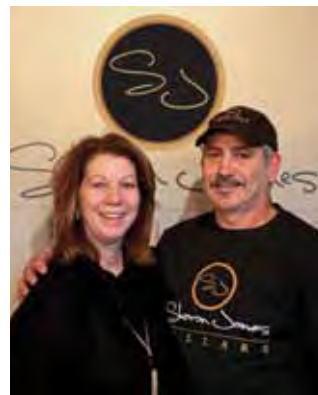

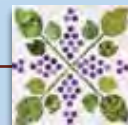
